Quoting Head Coach Amy Bond

"It's always important to have experience, and we've got four of the five that have actually played in the national championship before. To me that's big because they know exactly what's going to happen. Barring a weather hiccup, they should have an idea of what each day holds and what they need to do in order to make the eight.

"I think this is the fourth time in the last four or five years that I really feel that we are peaking at the right time. There's a lot of confidence going in to this week which is always important. Confidence is the biggest thing; if they believe they can do it, chances are they've got a good shot.

"For them to go and shoot low (at the NCAA Tallahassee regional) and everybody to contribute to it is really big. I think it's good to have the three seniors that have experience – I think that's going to be a key as we are one of the few teams that actually has all of that experience.

"This group is going to leave a legacy not only on the golf course but off the golf course. They had helped change our program from a team that's in the mid-30s to a team that's consistently in the top 25. To me, this is a special group all together, but one that I'm going to miss when they leave."

FLORIDA STATE ADVANCES TO PLAY IN NCAA CHAMPIONSHIP FINALS FOR THIRD CONSECUTIVE SEASON SEMINOLES ARRIVE AT KARSTEN CREEK WITH CONSECUTIVE RUNNER-UP FINISHES AT ACC CHAMPIONSHIP AND NCAA TALLAHASSEE REGIONAL

NO. 21 FLORIDA STATE BEGINS PLAY IN NCAA CHAMPIONSHIP FINALS FRIDAY

Florida State, which has finished as the runner-up in both of its last two tournaments – the ACC Championship and the NCAA Tallahassee Regional Championship, travels to the Karsten Creek Golf Club in Stillwater, Okla., to play in the 2018 NCAA Women's Golf Championship Finals. The Seminoles are playing in the event for the school-record third consecutive season. **Florida State qualified for the NCAA Championship Finals with a second place finish in the 2018 NCAA Tallahassee Regional Championship – the school-record third consecutive year the Seminoles have finished in the top three at a regional championship.** The 2018 NCAA Division I women's golf champion will be decided after four rounds of stroke play (May 18-21) and three rounds of match play (May 22-23).

FLORIDA STATE MAKES ITS 10TH NCAA APPEARANCE

Florida State is making its 10th appearance in the NCAA Women's Golf Championship Finals. The Seminoles are playing in the NCAA Championship finals for the 10th season (1992, 94, 99, 03, 04, 06, 10, 16, 17, 18) and for the school-record third consecutive year. The Seminoles' appearance in the 2018 NCAA Championship Finals marks the first time in school history Florida State has competed in the NCAA golf championship finals in three consecutive seasons.

NOTING SEMINOLES HEAD COACH AMY BOND

Seminole Head Coach Amy Bond has been a member of seven of Florida State's 10 NCAA Championship Finals teams (1999 as a player; 2004, 2004, 2006 as an assistant coach; 2016, 2017, 2018 as its head coach).

MORGANE METRAUX AND DOHERTY EARN ALL-WOMEN'S GOLF HONORS

Senior Morgane Metraux and sophomore Amanda Doherty, who have helped lead the Florida State Women's Golf Team into the NCAA Championships for the 10th time, were named to the All-ACC team as voted on by the league's 12 head coaches and announced by the ACC office. It marks the 18th consecutive season at least one Seminole has been named to the All-ACC women's golf team. The selections of Metraux and Doherty marks the fourth time in the last five years the Seminoles have had multiple players named to the All-ACC team.

SEMINOLES FINISH SECOND AT NCAA TALLAHASSEE REGIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP

Senior Morgane Metraux and sophomore Amanda Doherty both finished in a tie for fourth place in the individual standings, and the **Seminole women's golf team finished in second place in the team standings** at the 2018 NCAA Division I Women's Golf Tallahassee Regional Championship at the Don Veller Seminole Golf Club. In tying the school record for best team finish in an NCAA Regional Championship (second), the Seminoles placed two players (Morgane Metraux and Amanda Doherty, both tied for fourth) in the top five of the individual standings in an NCAA regional for the first time in school history. The individual scores of 206 by Metraux and Doherty are tied for the sixth best in school history and ranks the best in school history in NCAA regional of finals competition.

FLORIDA STATE FINISHES SECOND AT THE ACC CHAMPIONSHIPS

Senior Morgane Metraux finished in a tie for third and sophomore Amanda Doherty finished in a tie for fifth in the individual standings, and the Florida State women's golf team finished in second place in the team standings in the 2018 ACC Championships at the Grandover Resort in Greensboro, N.C. The individual finishes for Morgane Metraux and Doherty marked the first time in school history the Seminoles had two players finish in the top five of the ACC Championships. **Florida State's second place team finish marked the first time in school history the Seminoles finished in the top-two in consecutive seasons after also finishing in second place in 2017.**

NOTING AMANDA DOHERTY AND MORGANE METRAUX IN 2018

Sophomore Amanda Doherty (nine strokes under par) and senior Morgane Metraux (four strokes under par) both enter the NCAA Championship Finals with under par stroke averages for the ENTIRE year. Doherty enters the championship finals with a career-low 71.61 stroke average while Metraux enters the event with a 71.82 stroke average. **Doherty's average is the best for a single season while Metraux's average is the second best for a single season in school history.**

SEMINOLES' NCAA CHAMPIONSHIP FINALS LINEUP AND FSU CAREER RANK

Florida State's NCAA Championship Finals lineup – seniors Kim Metraux, Morgane Metraux and Kayla Jones, sophomore Amanda Doherty and freshman Kathleen Sumner – consists of five of the top nine golfers (statistically) in school history. Matilda Castren (2014-17), who played in four NCAA Regional Championships during her career at Florida State, is the Seminoles' all-time leader with a 72.52 stroke average in 126 career rounds.

FLORIDA STATE RANKED SECOND IN THE ACC IN STROKE AVERAGE

Florida State enters the 2018 NCAA Championship Finals with a 290.9 stroke average in 28 rounds – the second lowest stroke average in the ACC and the second lowest in school history.

FLORIDA STATE'S TEAM FINISHES

Florida State has earned three runner-up team finishes this season (second of 15 at the Ocean Course Invitational; second of 12 at the ACC Championships and second of 18 in the NCAA Tallahassee Regional). The Seminoles are one of only four teams in the ACC with at least three team finishes of second place or better. The list includes Florida State, Duke (seven finishes of second place or better), Louisville (four finishes of second place or better) and Miami (three finishes of second place or better).

SEMINOLES FINISHES IN THEIR LAST TWO EVENTS

With two second place finishes in its last two events (the ACC Championship and the NCAA Tallahassee Regional), the Seminoles enter the NCAA Championship Finals playing their best golf of the year. Florida State is 13 strokes under par (12 strokes over par at the ACC Championships and 25 strokes under par in the NCAA Tallahassee Regional) in its last two events entering the NCAA Championship Finals with their only two losses coming to No. 1 Alabama (in the Tallahassee Regional Championship) and to No. 4 Duke (in the ACC Championships). As a team, Florida State is a cumulative total of even par in its last five events and is under par (five under) in its last four events since finishing the Evans Derby Experience at one over par on March 20.

NOTING FLORIDA STATE'S TEAM SCORE IN THE TALLAHASSEE REGIONAL

Florida State's 25 under par score of 839 in the NCAA Tallahassee Regional ranks as the third best overall score and second best score vs. par in a three round tournament in school history. The Seminoles' near school-record finish in the NCAA Tallahassee Regional Championship marked the fifth time in school history they had finished 20 or more strokes under par in a three round tournament.

SEMINOLES RANKED SECOND IN ACC WITH LOW ROUND SCORES

Florida State, which carded a 12 under par round of 276 in the third round of the NCAA Tallahassee Regional Championship, owns three of the 10 lowest team rounds in the ACC during the 2017-18 fall and spring seasons. The Seminoles have record four team rounds under par this year with three coming during the 2018 spring season. Florida State owns three of the lowest 10 rounds and is second only to Duke in that statistical category. Duke has carded four of the lowest 10 team rounds in the ACC this season.

FLORIDA STATE'S BEST ROUND AT THE NCAA TALLAHASSEE REGIONAL

PAIR OF SEMINOLES IN THE ACC'S TOP SIX FOR STROKE AVERAGE

Florida State's Amanda Doherty (Fifth, 71.61) and Morgane Metraux (Sixth, 71.82) are both ranked among the top six individuals for stroke average in the ACC in 2018. The Seminoles, Duke and Wake Forest have two players each in the top six of the individual stroke leaders in the ACC.

DOHERTY AMONG ACC LEADERS FOR TOP-FIVE AND TOP-10 FINISHES

Sophomore Amanda Doherty is tied for third in the ACC with a career-high four top-five finishes (Florida State Match-Up, 2; Brickyard Collegiate, T2; NCAA Tallahassee Regional, T4 and ACC Championship T5). The ACC leader for top-five individual finishes is Jennifer Kupcho of Wake Forest with five. Doherty is tied for sixth in the ACC with a career-high five top-10 finishes (Florida State Match-Up, 2; Brickyard Collegiate, T2; NCAA Tallahassee Regional, T4 and ACC Championship T5; Ocean Course Invitational, T10).

DOHERTY MAKING A LIVING IN THE 60'S

Sophomore All-ACC selection Amanda Doherty leads the Seminoles with six rounds carded in the 60's during the fall 2017 and spring 2018 seasons. She

carded two rounds in the 60's during the NCAA Tallahassee Regional Championships (69 in the first round and a career-low 66 in the second round) and has carded at least one round in the 60's in four of her 11 events this season. Doherty carded multiple rounds in the 60's in the Florida State Match-Up and the NCAA Tallahassee Regional Championship.

AMANDA DOHERTY'S RANKINGS

Sophomore Amanda Doherty enters the 2018 NCAA Championship Finals ranked as one of the top golfers in school history. Her career scoring average of 73.02 (4,819 strokes in 66 rounds during 22 tournaments) is ranked as the second lowest career scoring average in school history. Doherty's career-low 71.61 stroke average as a sophomore (2,220 strokes in 31 rounds during 11 tournaments) is the BEST single season career average in school history. She is 0.5 strokes behind the all-time career stroke average of Matilda Castren (2014-17, 72.52) and is a near a tie with teammate Morgane Metraux for the Seminoles' all-time single-season mark (71.61)

METRAUX ENTERS NCAA TOURNAMENT WITH TOP TWO ALL-TIME SCORES

Senior Morgane Metraux enters the 2018 NCAA Championship Finals with the top two scores for a three round tournament on her Florida State resume. Her three round total of 201 at the 2016 Schooner Fall Classic is the best tournament score in school history while her total of 202 in the 2017 Dickson Intercollegiate is the second best three round score in school history. Metraux's 206 total and minus 10 strokes under par total in the 2018 NCAA Tallahassee Regional Championship is ranked as the fifth lowest three round individual tournament score in school history.

NOTING MORGANE METRAUX'S TOTAL OF THE 2017 DICKSON

Morgane Metraux's 202 score at the 2017 Dickson Intercollegiate (14-under par) is the best score vs. par in school history. It is one of nine scores for a three-round tournament that have been recorded at double digits under par.

KIM METRAUX UNDER PAR

Senior Kim Metraux, who will play in her third career NCAA Championship this week, has finished two of her events this year under par. She finished the Schooner Fall Classic at 1 under par (212, tied for 16th) and finished the Evans Derby Experience at 3 under par (213, tied for 12th). Metraux has finished eight events under par in her 42-event career.

KIM METRAUX'S CONSISTENCY

Senior Kim Metraux has played as one of the most consistent golfers in school history throughout her four-year Florida State career. As a freshman, she averaged 75.57 strokes in 23 rounds. In the three years since her freshman season, she has averaged 73.53 strokes in 35 tournaments (7,424 strokes in 101 rounds). Metraux has averaged 73.53 (sophomore season), 73.43 (junior season) and 73.68 (senior season) in each of her last three seasons. She holds three of the top 15 single season scoring averages in school history and is ranked sixth in school history with her 73.91 career average entering the 2018 NCAA Regional Championship Finals in Stillwater.

SUMNER'S FRESHMAN SEASON AMONG BEST IN SCHOOL HISTORY

Kathleen Sumner, who has earned two top-10 finishes as a freshman this year (tied for sixth at the Dickson Intercollegiate and tied for seventh at the Brickyard Collegiate) enters her first NCAA Championship Finals event with a 74.87 stroke average – the fifth best by a freshman in school history. The school record for best average by a freshman is 71.83 by Matilda Castren in 2014. In the Seminoles' lineup this week in Stillwater are four players (Amanda Doherty, third; Morgane Metraux, fourth; Sumner, fifth, and Kayla Jones, seventh) who all ranked in the top 10 for best averages by a freshman in school history.
